1	<ul> <li>ESSENTIAL DOCUMENTS</li> <li>Social Security numbers for you, your spouse, and any dependents.</li> <li>Bank account information for direct deposit of your refund.</li> <li>Will you be able to continue your current lifestyle comfortably?</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>INCOME DOCUMENTATION</li> <li>W-2 forms from all employers.</li> <li>1099 forms if you're self-employed or have other income such as rent, dividends, interest, and pensions.</li> <li>SSA-1099 for Social Security benefits received.</li> </ul>
3	<ul> <li>EXPENSE RECORDS- (Receipts for any qualifying deductions including):</li> <li>Medical and dental expenses.</li> <li>Property taxes and mortgage interest.</li> <li>Educational expenses.</li> <li>Records of charitable donations: cash amounts and descriptions of donated property.</li> </ul>
4	<ul> <li>CREDITS AND DEDUCTIONS</li> <li>Childcare expenses: provider's name, address, and tax ID.</li> <li>Educational expenses: Form 1098-T from educational institutions, receipts related to educational expenses.</li> <li>Homebuyer credits: HUD-1 settlement statement if you purchased a home.</li> </ul>
5	<ul> <li>VETERAN SPECIFIC</li> <li>☐ Record of any moving expenses if you relocated due to a permanent change of station.</li> <li>☐ Documentation of any combat pay, grants, or benefits received related to your service.</li> </ul>
6	<ul> <li>ADDITIONAL TIPS:</li> <li>Double-Check: Before you file, double-check that all numbers on your forms match your records.</li> <li>Electronic Filing: Consider e-filing to reduce errors and get your refund faster.</li> <li>Tax Software: If using tax software, ensure it is updated to the latest version for accurate processing.</li> </ul>
